Doylestown, PA – On Saturday evening, March 12, 2016, newly-formed local band, **Barefoot Bobby and the Breakers** held a Beef & Beer Benefit for Local Veterans at the Keenan Motors Mercedes dealership in Doylestown. The entire event profit amount from ticket sales, raffling off donated prize baskets, a 50/50 drawing, and a “Win the Band for Your Summer Party” raffle contest was **proudly presented this week to the A.R. Atkinson Jr. American Legion Post 210 in the form of a \$5,000 check.** The event was originally scheduled for January 23rd at the legion hall. It had to be cancelled due to weather. Relocating to Keenan made it possible to sell another 145 tickets until capacity was reached and the event sold out again. It was attended by about 385 people. The success of the event was largely due to the generosity of Keenan Motors, the efforts of the Doylestown Post 210 American Legion Baseball team, and the team manager Mr. Steve Ruane. Many band family members, friends, volunteers from the team, Post 210 veterans, corporate sponsors, and supporters of the band and our troops worked hard to make the night a success. These people and businesses will be formally recognized at a presentation during an upcoming Legion Post 210 meeting.

The event was one of a series of fund-raising events that Barefoot Bobby and the Breakers are supporting this year. The Breakers played at a benefit for Bucks County Special Needs on Feb. 2nd at Chambers 19 in Doylestown. They are back at Chambers 19 on March 20th to support Camp Cranium, an organization helping children with brain injuries. Barefoot Bobby and the Breakers will also be featured performers this year at The 9th Annual Sarah Parvin Memorial Soccerfest in Quakertown to help support their fight against cancer. These are all worthy causes and the band encourages you to support them.
